You Restore Hope: Diane's Story

My life was pretty average. Ordinary, really, until a series of unfortunate events hit. My husband of 25 years suddenly died of a heart attack at age 50. I was only 48 at the time with 2 young adult children ready to leave the nest. I began to drink all day to soothe the pain. I realized I was losing control. The same day I'd decided to commit to recovery, I was diagnosed with breast cancer. Because of the treatments, I spent two years sober, but relapsed into destructive living as soon as I healed from the medical procedures. As I attempted sobriety, I found myself living more and more isolated. Suddenly, for the first time in my life, I was completely alone. I am an identical twin, so when I say "alone," I mean that I've never been alone my whole life.

I was raised in a Catholic home, but I didn't fully understand or embrace the Christian way of life. I was lost, both physically and spiritually empty. I had turned to alcohol to ease, fix, and hide many feelings and emotions. Alcoholics Anonymous' Big Book describes addiction as 'cunning, baffling, and powerful,' and this was certainly true for me. It was only then I realized that I was powerless and my life had become unmanageable. I spiraled out of control and was blacking out and losing entire days. I could not keep a job, and was eventually evicted from my apartment. My family had given me all the help they could, and gave me an ultimatum: I must go to Shirley's to get help, or they would have to cut contact.

I realized that only a 'Higher Power' greater than myself could restore my sanity. Only with the help of God and Shirley's House of Hope could I make the decision to turn my will and life over to God.

Nine months is a long commitment. I was scared to death of recovery. The Shirley's House of Hope staff came alongside me and helped me find the loving power and stability that God can have in all of our lives. At 55, I had lost everything: my home, my job, my life companion, my car, my driver's license, and nearly lost the rest of my family. They guided me, helped me set boundaries and rules, they helped me look for and find a new job, and helped me save money to move out on my own! I felt like I was 15, but with their help I have been able to become an adult again. I now have hope for what could be the second half of my life in front of me!

I tend to think in 'creative scenes,' so I imagine my life as a picture of myself hiking up a rocky hill or on a rigorous bike ride, looking over and realizing that Jesus is and has been right by my side . . . this whole time!

My self-esteem has been restored, and I've developed a powerful positive attitude that will allow me to help and provide guidance to other struggling women; to hopefully lead by example and become the woman that others want to emulate. Thank you to Kathy and the other staff at Shirley's for giving me a second chance at life. Thank you to my spiritual mentor, my AA sponsor, and my friends and family for not giving up on me.
