Transitional Housing Center - 3 women

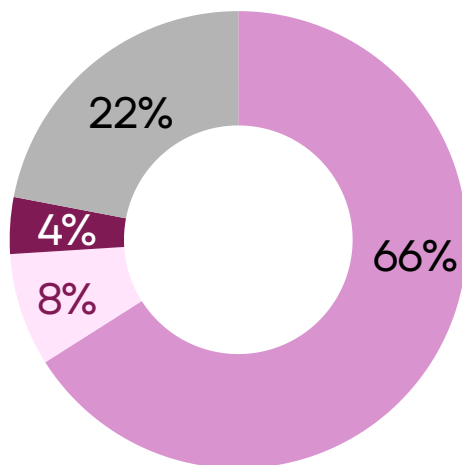

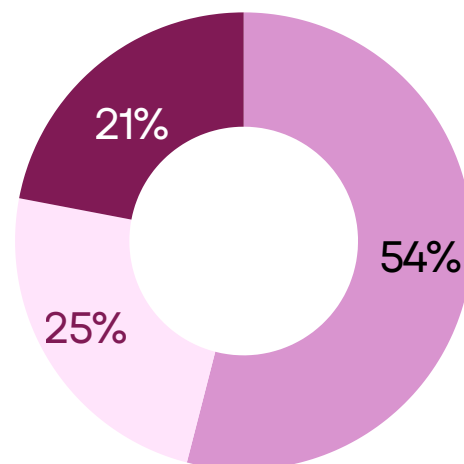
