Since October 1, 2010, 635 women and children have been served.

Transitional Housing Center - 3 women

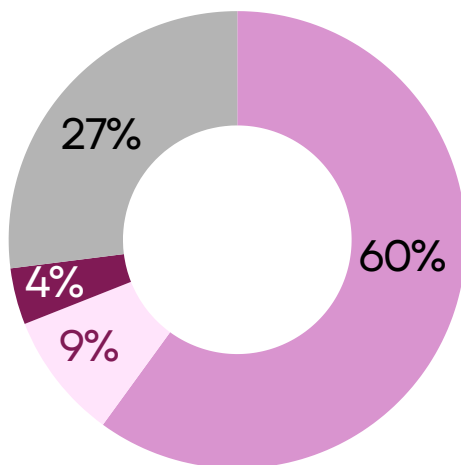
